**ATV's** – usage is limited to trails designated by the Washburn County Forestry Department. ATV's are **not** permitted on our town roads or road right of ways and must be trailered to/from a designated trail. Until state legislation establishes laws similar to those for snowmobiles the Casey Town Board deems the liability risk and maintenance costs too great. Anyone observing violations should contact WDNR Warden Dave Swanson at (715) 466-5428 or the Washburn County Sheriff's Dept. at (715) 468-4720.

**Driveway and Building Permits** – An approved Town Driveway Permit must be submitted to the Washburn County Zoning Office when applying for building permits. Driveway Permit applications can be obtained on our website or from Casey Town Clerk Corinne Slabaugh, at (715) 635-7580. Assisting us with this process the County Zoning Office will not issue any building/sanitary permits unless a completed and approved Town Driveway Permit is presented. A Building Permit is required for any structure that has a footprint of greater than sixty-four square feet.

**Fireworks Usage** – Wisconsin statutes require a permit for use of all non hand-held fireworks and will be issued up to June 29th by Casey Town Board Chairperson, Gene Bethel. Valid only if burning conditions warrant, the permit allows detonation between the hours 9 pm and midnight from **Friday July 2nd thru Sunday July 4th**.
