TOWN OF CASEY

LICENSE ORDINANCE

10-89 B

WHEREAS the Town has issued licenses for the sale of alcoholic beverages to various individuals that have not actively operated businesses within the Town; and,

WHEREAS the Town may enact or prescribe additional regulations for the sale of alcoholic beverages pursuant to Wis. Stats. §125.10 provided such additional regulations do not conflict with Chapter 125 of the Wis. Stats; and,

WHEREAS license applicants have been denied by reason of the unavailability of licenses within the Town;

NOW THEREFORE the Town Board of Supervisors of the Township of Casey, Washburn County, Wisconsin does ordain as follows:

1. Any person licensed by the Town to sell intoxicating liquor or fermented malt beverages shall operate and be open as a business upon the premises of that persons license or permit for not less than 30 business days per license year, a business establishment for the sale of alcoholic beverages or fermented malt beverages.

2. Upon the failure of the person licensed to operate and be open as a business for 30 days or more during any license year, the Town Board may refuse to renew that persons license in accordance with Wis. Stats. §125.12(3).

3. For the purposes of this Ordinance, the definition of the words "person", "intoxicating liquor", "fermented malt beverages", "license", "permit", "person" or "premises" shall

have those definitions as set forth in Wis. Stats. §125.02. The term "license year" is defined as the term of licensing from July 1 to June 30, annually.

4. This ordinance shall take effect upon publication.

The foregoing ordinance was adopted at a regularly scheduled meeting of the Board of Supervisors, Town of Casey, Washburn County, Wisconsin on October 10, 1989.
