Snow Plowing and Road Maintenance- is performed by Norton Excavating. All concerns involving snow plowing or road maintenance should be addressed to the Casey Town Board at the monthly meeting and **NOT** Norton Excavating.

Driveway and building permits- An approved Town Driveway Permit must be submitted to the Washburn County Zoning Office when applying for building permits. Driveway Permit applications can be obtained on our website or from Casey Town Clerk Corinne Slabaugh, at (715) 635-7580. Assisting us with this process the County Zoning Office will not issue any building /sanitary permits unless a completed and approved Town Driveway Permit is presented. Fireworks Usage- Wisconsin statutes require a permit for use of all non-handheld fireworks and will be issued through June 28, 2018 by Casey Town Board Chairperson: Tom Mackie (715) 635-3656; W9065 Lower McKenzie Rd., Spooner, WI 54801. **Valid only if burning conditions warrant. The permit allows detonation between the hours of 9 p.m. and midnight from Saturday June 30th through Saturday July 7th, 2018. The permitting is longer this year due to the 4th falling evenly between two weekends.** *A separate application and permit must be obtained for each day of fireworks usage.* Please check our website for information and permit applications.

Tentative Road Construction- Permit applications and cost estimates are being looked at for work on Island Lake Rd. north of E and south of Dunn Lake Rd. Please see meeting minutes for updates.

BEWARE-Zebra mussels have been found in Big McKenzie Lake!! **PLEASE** clean all boats & water toys before using another body of water. If there is a denomination station at a landing it **MUST** be used by LAW.
