Driveway and building permits- An approved Town Driveway Permit must be submitted to the Washburn County Zoning Office when applying for building permits. Driveway Permit applications can be obtained on our website or from Casey Town Clerk Corinne Slabaugh, at (715) 635-7580. Assisting us with this process the County Zoning Office will not issue any building /sanitary permits unless a completed and approved Town Driveway Permit is presented. Fireworks Usage- Wisconsin statutes require a permit for use of all non-hand-help fireworks and will be issued through June 28, 2017 by Casey Town Board Chairperson: Tom Mackie (715) 635-3656; W9065 Lower McKenzie Rd., Spooner, WI 54801. **Valid only if burning conditions warrant. The permit allows detonation between the hours of 9 p.m. and midnight from Saturday July 1st and Tuesday July 4th.** *A separate application and permit must be obtained for each day of fireworks usage.* Please check our website for information and permit applications.

Tentative Road Construction- Re-engineering of Casey Lake Boat Landing Rd. & Sunfish Lake Rd. Permit application has begun for the south end of Island Lake Rd., Deer Lake Rd., & Leisure Lake Rd.
