To Whom It May Concern:

It has been brought to the attention of the Casey Town Board that whoever is plowing your private driveway is pushing snow out through your access onto the public road. This practice often is an attempt to push snow across the public right-of-way on to the opposing snow bank. The Town of Casey has never questioned this practice as long as the snow pushed is not left on the right of way. This includes removal of snow ridges created by this plowing left on the road opposing the flow of vehicular traffic.

It is the opinion of the Casey Town Board this practice creates potentially hazardous conditions to those traveling our roads. If this practice does not cease, the Casey Town Board will notify the Washburn County Sheriff's Department to issue citation in violation of Wis. Stat. 346.94 (5) PLACING INJURIOUS SUBSTANCE ON HIGHWAY.

The Casey Town Board duty is to protect all those traveling our roads. We ask you to assure this potential hazard created by depositing snow onto or creating snow ridges on the public road is ended. It is our extreme best wish to gain your compliance. We sincerely believe notification of this problem will bring assurances of ceasing this potentially hazardous practice leaving intervention by the sheriff's department unnecessary.
